## Market Summary

The stock market on Thursday opened on a bullish note. However, some of earlier gains were eroded in the second half and concluded the session in the green zone amid improved current account surplus, expectation of further decline in inflation and positive outlook on IMF programme. The Benchmark KSE-100 index made an intra-day high and low at 82,003.58 (1,542.25 points) and 80,680.23 (218.90 points) respectively while closed at 81,459.28 by gainig 997.95 points. PKR in today's interbank appreciated by Rs 0.1291 against USD and closed at Rs277.9132. The value of shares traded during the day was Rs18.601 billion. Market capitalization stood at around Rs10.664 trillion. Overall, trading volumes for the day increased to 458.29 million shares compared with Wednesday's tally of 397.91 million. KOSM was the volume leader with 35.2 million shares, losing Rs0.82 to close at Rs8.01. It was followed by KEL with 23.8 million shares, losing Rs0.06 to close at Rs3.99 and WTL with 22.9 million shares,losing Rs0.03 to close at Rs1.33.

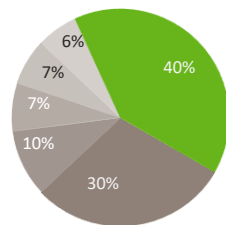

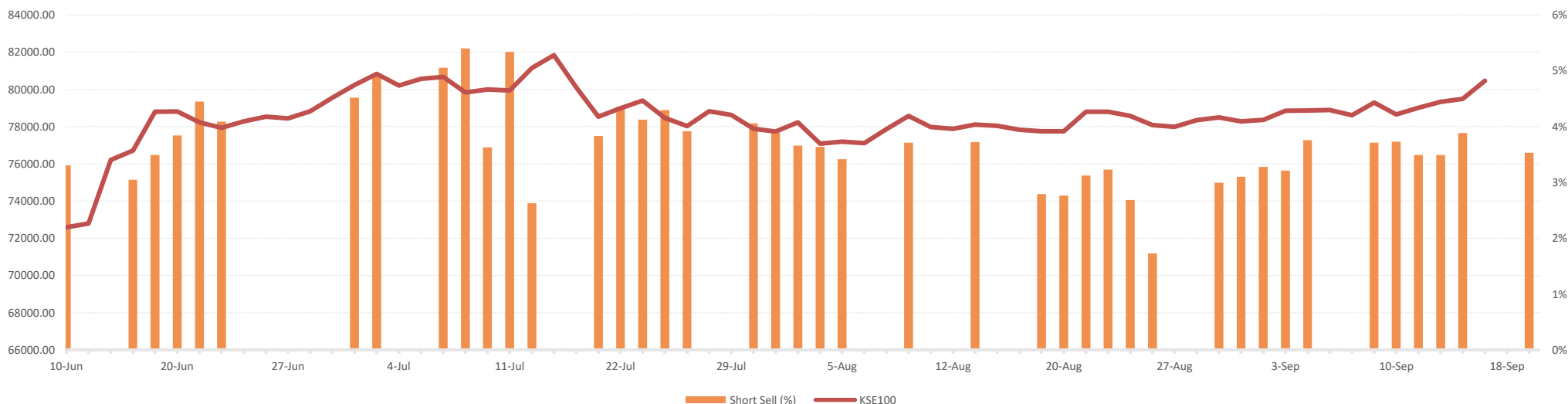
